



BOULES



What You Need:

- 8 metal balls (boules) 4 of each pattern
- 1 small wooden ball (jack or cochonnet)
- Measuring device (optional)
- Outdoor playing area (gravel, sand, or dirt)

How to Play:

- 1. Choose a playing area and draw a starting circle.
- 2. Players take turns throwing the jack 6-10 meters away.
- 3. Players alternate throwing boules, trying to get closer to the jack.
- 4. Each player throws all their boules.
- 5. Points scored by having boules closer to the jack than opponent's closest boule.

How to Win:

- 1. Score points by having boules closer to the jack.
- 2. Game played to 13 points.
- 3. Must win by 2 points (e.g., 13-11, not 13-12).
- 4. Winning team scores difference between points (e.g., 13-11 = 2 points).

Scoring:

- Each boule closer to the jack than opponent's closest: 1 point
- If tied, no points awarded

Additional Rules:

- Foul: Boule or jack out of bounds or moved: opponent scores
- Dead boule: Removed from play if damaged or out of bounds
- Measuring: Used to determine closest boule

Variations:

- Singles or doubles
- Team play (3-4 players)
- Time limit

Key Terms:

- "Pointing": Throwing boules to get closer to the jack
- "Shooting": Knocking opponent's boule out of play
